The Vision

- In order to further the care for citizens across the globe, collaborate on a single, **common International Patient Summary (IPS) specification**”

The IPS Scope

- *“Minimal and non-exhaustive Patient Summary, specialty-agnostic, condition-independent, but readily usable by all clinicians for the *unscheduled (cross-border) care of a patient.*”*

Principles for the IPS

- A. The standards specification for the IPS will be **implementable**
- Promote (the evolution and convergence of) existing standards
 - Rely on solutions that are already implemented or ready for implementation
 - Consider new or additional solutions as they become available

Principles for the IPS

- B. The standards specification for the IPS will be applicable for **global use**
- Strive for global accessibility of standards for free
 - Strive for a core set of globally accessible and broadly usable terminologies
 - Include free text in addition to the structured codes as needed
 - Do not include local solutions in that are not available in other jurisdictions

Principles for the IPS

- C.** The standards specification will be **extensible and open** to future use cases and solutions
 - The IPS provides common content that can be extended for other use cases
 - The IPS is open to emerging solutions for unresolved issues or improvements

Principles for the IPS

- D. The standards specifications and their implementation will be **sustainable** through:
- A robust maintenance and update process for the IPS
 - A process to ensure clinical validity of the IPS, meeting
 - clinical requirements (including workflow)
 - clinical documentation requirements
 - information quality requirements

Principles for the IPS

- E. manage the expectations** of the IPS standards specifications among stakeholders, by
- stipulating the role of the IPS as a foundation for others to extend
 - justifying the inclusion of items in the IPS within the limited context of unplanned (cross border) care

Overall design approach

- High level view of the content of the document
 - List of sections => discussed with the IG structure

Confirmation of the purpose and content of the balloted package

- Define as part of the first version all (relevant) the sections we are aware should be included; for each section specify what we are able to specify [All] (the narrative part).
- Make clear that further refinements will included in the next versions
- Focus on CDA IG with an eye on FHIR
