# Scenario #1 (Discharge Summary)

Patient: ALBERT

Provider: ANTHONY CHUNG @ Good Health University Hospital

## Patient presents with the following symptoms:

- fainting, vomiting, diarrahea, weakness, dizziness, cold and clammy skin
- flu-like symptoms for the past two weeks

## Patient has the following conditions:

high cholesterol

#### **Incoming medications:**

- Crestor 10mg once a day for 100 days
- 100 days supply with 2 refills
- last dispensed 6 months before hospitalization
- Promethazine/Codeine syrup 30mg every 6-8 hours
- 500mg dispensed with no refills 4 days ago

#### Lab Tests done while hospitalized:

- EKG normal
- Chest CT scan pleural effusion in the right lung

Patient given fluids while hospitalized

#### **Assessment:**

- Concern over heart trouble negative due to EKG results
- Concern about over-medication of cold medicines
- Confirmed Community-acquired Pneumonia

## Discharge medications:

• Levaquin 500mg once a day for 7 days
